Ideas - you could

- Arrange to clear up your local rubbish grot-spot, remove rubbish and weeds and replant with flowers or shrubs. Recycle and compost all of your waste.
- Look after your local area – pick up litter, help older people look after their gardens, look after your local recycling site, report streetlights that aren't working or street signs/bus shelters that are damaged.
- Give your local cycle track a face-lift, clear any rubbish, check the signs and road markings.
- Organise a waste awareness, road safety or public transport bus buddy campaign.

Design leaflets and posters, display them at your school and around your local community.

- Smarten up your local park with a litter pick up; fix fences, paint climbing frames or sand down and re-stain wooden seats or benches.
- Set up a swap shop for unwanted household items. Use any funds raised to buy things for your project or donate to a local charity.
