Communities within Humberside have changed dramatically since 2001, however Police Criminal Evidence Act Codes of Practice direct that census data be used for comparison. Population figures are believed to be up to between double and three times the 2001 census figures. ***This should be borne in mind during the scrutiny process***
Up to date census figures are due to be published in 2011.

Stop Search data

Highlight this Quarter

Stop and searches force wide and in B and D Divisions have decreased this quarter. There is some apparent disproportionality between the percentage of BME and white arrests; however the actual numbers involved in BME arrests are small.

Stop & search leading to arrest

Highlight this Quarter

The percentage of BME arrests are all above the BME population percentage.

DCC's Scrutiny Panel

Mr Griffin highlighted the 100% BME arrest rate in B Division.

DCC's Scrutiny Panel Action

B Division to examine the three BME stops which led to arrests and report back

Disposal methods for detainees

Highlight this Quarter

It was noted that out of date Census data is still being used. It is important that this data is examined to establish any emerging trends. It was reported that there has been an overall decrease in the number of prisoners dealt with.

DCC's Scrutiny Panel

Mr Griffin noted that the NFA percentages are worthy of note, the percentages given for BME and white are comparably close

Force tickets issued

Highlight this Quarter

It was reported that all tickets issued are above the BME population percentage. There has been a small increase in the number of VDRs issue to the BME community however the numbers are small. There are fluctuations in the number of tickets with undefined ethnicity. Divisionally similar observations can be made.

DCC's Scrutiny Panel Action

Further investigations to be made with the Central Ticket Office relating to tickets being received with undefined ethnicity and possible solutions.

Racially & Religiously aggravated crime

Highlight this Quarter

It was reported that this quarter there has been a decrease force wide and across all divisions in the number of racially and religiously aggravated crimes recorded and also in detections rates.

DCC's Scrutiny Panel

D Division reported that they are confident that they are able to reach the targets set by the Police Authority.

C Division reported that the actual updated detection figure for C Division is 8 and therefore the detection rate is 70%.
