SPECIFIC DETAILS

Population data

Data for each quarter is examined, and compared to the 2001 population census data. Communities within Humberside have changed dramatically since 2001, however Police Criminal Evidence Act Codes of Practice direct that census data be used for comparison. Population figures are believed to be up to between double and three times the 2001 census figures. **This should be borne in mind during the scrutiny process**
Up to date census figures are due to be published in 2011.

Stop Search data and Stop & search leading to arrest

Highlight This Quarter

It was reported that there has been a decrease in the number of stops recorded. It was noted that the arrest rate for A Division being 50% appears high, however the numbers involved are low being 2 out of 4 individuals.
Stop and talks in C Division appear high at 1,946 in comparison the rest of the force.

Highlight Year to Date

Some of the BME stops are double the current recorded population.
Some percentage conversion rates (from stop to arrest) show significant differences between the rates for white when compared to BME.
This is a new table and at this time there is no significant data to draw direct comparison with.

DCC's Scrutiny Panel Action

C Division representative to make enquiries as to why the number of stop/talks is high and report back.

Disposal methods for detainees

Highlight This Quarter

The percentages for Disposal Methods of Prisoners for this quarter are very similar to last, however in relation to prisoners sent to court on remand the percentage of BME prisoners is greater than white prisoners, the actual numbers for both white and BME have risen on the last quarter.
The number of prisoners for both BME and white on bail to Police Station have dropped this quarter by 3.5% and 4.8% respectively.

Highlight Year to Date

In relation to the year to date data there is a larger percentage of BME prisoners NFA'd than white prisoners.

DCC's Scrutiny Panel

Mr Griffin stated that historically main area of concern has been with NFAs but noted that in this quarter the percentages are very similar and that it is good to see parity between the groups.

It was noted that the number of prisoners sent to court on remand is greater for BME prisoners, however the seriousness of the actual offences involved are

Force tickets issued

Highlight

Force wide the total number of tickets issued with ethnicity recorded has decreased on the last quarter with the exception of Vehicle Defect Notices which have increased by 163.

With the exception of PND's, all Fixed Penalty Notices issued Force wide this quarter and year to date are all above the BME percentage population, however the numbers involved are relatively small.

Again there are a significant number of Unknown ethnicities recorded for tickets where the person receiving the ticket should be present. Officers have been made aware of the need to fully complete the relevant documentation, however this reminder was published following the December meeting and therefore an improvement may not be evident until the next quarter.

DCC's Scrutiny Panel

Representatives to ascertain when the 2011 Census figures will be published and available for use.

Racially & Religiously aggravated crime

Highlight

The Force detection rate has increased this quarter by 1.7%. B and C Division have seen a marked increase in detection rates to 50% which is above the Force average. A and D Divisions' detection rates have dropped, however D Division's detection rate remains higher than the Force average.
