SPECIFIC DETAILS

D

Division litation data

Data for each quarter is examined, and compared to the 2001 population census data. Communities within Humberside have changed dramatically since 2001, however Police Criminal Evidence Act Codes of Practice direct that census data be used for comparison. Population figures are believed to be up to between double and three times the 2001 census figures. ***This should be borne in mind during the scrutiny process***
Up to date census figures are due to be published in 2011.

Stop Search data

Highlight this Quarter

The total number of stop and searches has decreased this quarter as have the total number of BME stop and searches.

DCC's Scrutiny Panel

A and D Division confirmed that stop and search is being used in crime hot spots and for targeted operations, this has been reviewed and the Divisions are content that it is being correctly.

DCC Griffin stated that he is content that there is no evidence of ethnic disproportionality however requested a corporate approach.

DCC's Scrutiny Panel Action

Chief Inspectors to establish a corporate approach to the appropriate use of the stop and search.

Stop & search leading to arrest

Highlight this Quarter

The percentage BME arrests for A and D Division is 0%.

DCC's Scrutiny Panel Action

D Division to monitor stop to arrest rates within the Division.

Disposal methods for detainees

Highlight this Quarter

There has again been a decrease in the number of prisoners dealt with. There has been a 4.5% increase of BME prisoners 'on bail to police station'.

DCC's Scrutiny Panel

DCC Griffin confirmed that there is rough parity in the figures and that he is content that there is no disproportionality.

Force tickets issued

Highlight this Quarter

Force wide with the exception of VDRs all tickets issued to the BME community are the same or less than the previous quarter. There has been a rise in the number of unknown ethnicities which does affect the figures.

DCC's Scrutiny Panel Action

Chief Inspectors to apply appropriate pressure to officers to ensure compliance in relation to ethnicity recording on force tickets.

Racially & Religiously aggravated crime

Highlight this Quarter

The number of racially and religiously aggravated crimes has decreased this quarter, as have detection rates.

DCC's Scrutiny Panel

It was noted that alternative outcomes and disposals, for example Restorative Practice are being used and these will affect detection rates.

DCC's Scrutiny Panel Action

DCC Griffin requested that alternative outcomes and disposals are included in the main scrutiny report.
