SPECIFIC DETAILS

Population data

Data for each quarter is examined, and compared to the 2001 population census data. Communities within Humberside have changed dramatically since 2001, however Police Criminal Evidence Act Codes of Practice direct that census data be used for comparison. Population figures are believed to be up to between double and three times the 2001 census figures. ***This should be borne in mind during the scrutiny process***
Up to date census figures are due to be published in 2011.

Stop Search data

Force wide stop and searches for both white and BME have decreased on the last quarter.
For year to date figures, there has been a decrease of over 3000 stop and searches, the majority of these being for whites and the largest proportion being in D Division.

Stop & search leading to arrest

There have been no arrests as a result of stop and search on members of the BME community. There is a marked difference in the percentage arrest rates for white stop and searches across the divisions, C Division's arrest rate being 1%.
For year to date figures, the number of white arrests has decreased force wide, however the numbers involved are not proportionate to the decrease in stop and searches..

Disposal methods for detainees

The number of disposal methods used this quarter has fallen for white prisoners by 447 but increased for BME by 27.
All methods of disposal have decreased for white prisoners, however there are fluctuations in the disposal methods used for BME, the largest increase being to court (not on remand) and on bail to Police Station.
There is generally parity between the percentage rates for disposals except in relation to Warnings and TICs.

In relation to the year to date data there are fluctuations in the number of disposal methods used for prisoners, the largest decrease for white and BME being in relation to Warnings and NFAs. There has also been a large increase in relation to TICs for BME prisoners.
There is generally parity between the percentage rates for disposals except in relation to Warnings and TICs.

Force tickets issued

There are fluctuations in the number of tickets issued, the most notable decreases being for tickets issued to White - North European.

Racially & Religiously aggravated crime

The number of Racially and Religiously Aggravated Crimes is down this quarter with the exception of C Division.
The number of crimes detected has fallen or stayed the same in all divisions.
There have been improvements to the detections rates on the South Bank, the detection rates on the North Bank have fallen, however the decrease in C Division can be explained due to an anomaly in the data for the last quarter.
