

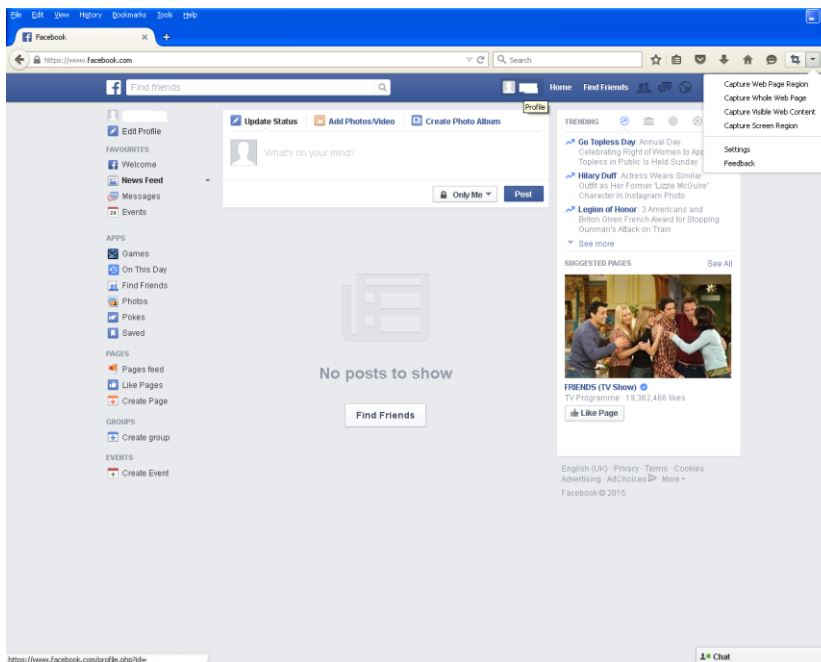


How do you find the Account reference for a Facebook Profile or Group?

NOTE: This method is available from a web-based version of Facebook. This method may also be different depending on the web browser used. This document is for illustration purposes only. Also, the methods of this identification process are subject to change by Facebook and there is no guarantee that the method will remain in the same format.

To identify a person's Facebook Profile reference on your Account, please follow these steps.

1. The User must log into their profile, on a web-based version. Place your mouse cursor over the account name you wish to identify the reference of. From here, look at the bottom left corner of the web page and you SHOULD see; <https://www.facebook.com/profile.php?id=>. After the 'id=' there will be a long account reference, usually about 15 digits. Some account profiles MAY also show as 'id=theirname'. If their name is shown and it is different the current account name, this will be the original registered account name. Please see image below.

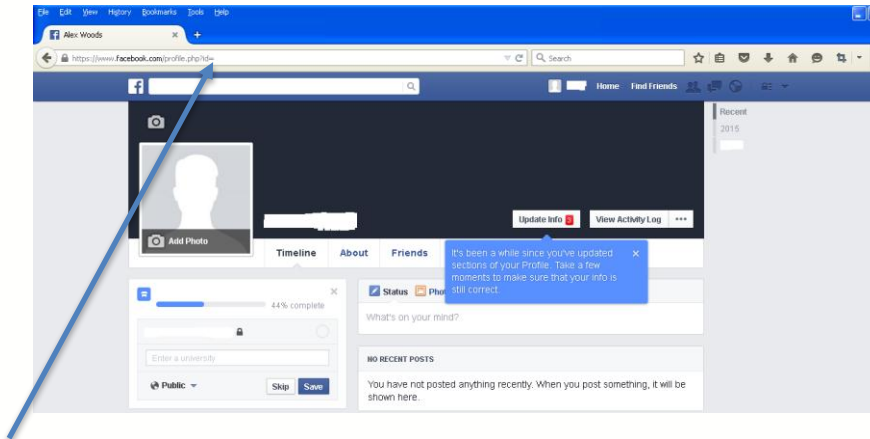

2. Alternatively, the user must log into their profile, on a web-based and **CLICK** on the account name you wish to identify the reference of. Once the account page has loaded. If you look at the Uniform Resource Locator (URL) in the address bar. You



SHOULD see; <https://www.facebook.com/profile.php?id=>. After the 'id=' there will be a long account reference, usually about 15 digits. Some account profiles MAY also show as 'id=theirname'. If their name is shown and it is different the current account name, this will be the original registered account name. Please see image below.

3. To identify the group reference, the user must log into their profile, on a web-based and **CLICK** on the group name you wish to identify the reference of. Once the account page has loaded. If you look at the Uniform Resource Locator (URL) in the address bar. You SHOULD see; <https://www.facebook.com/groups/>. After the 'groups/' there will be a long account reference, usually about 16 digits.
