

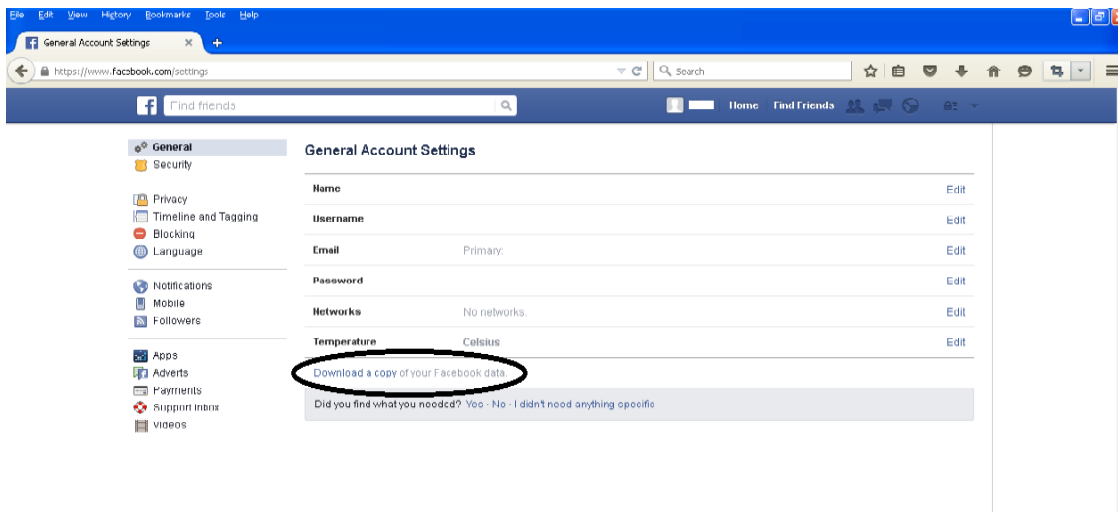


How does a victim download their Facebook Profile?

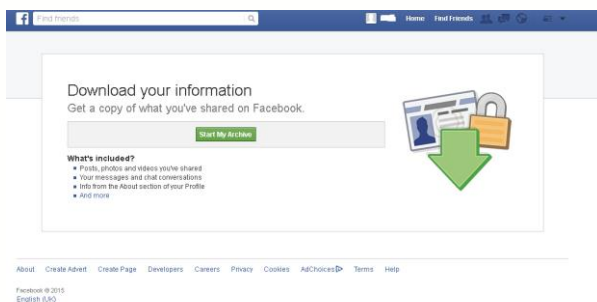

To download the Facebook archive, please follow these steps.

1. The User must log into their profile and **CLICK** on the downward chevron which appears on the Users profile toolbar (in Blue). The chevron is located next to a PADLOCK symbol.
2. A 'drop down' menu will appear, **CLICK** the option for 'Settings'.
3. The following screen will appear with your Account information in the fields:

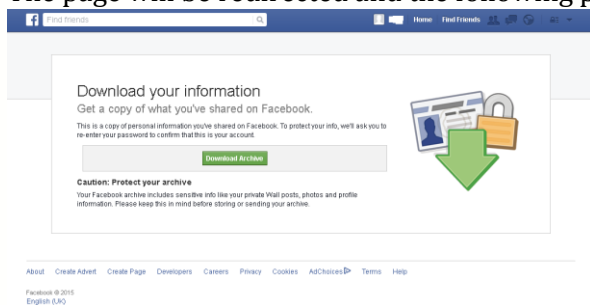


4. **CLICK** on 'Download a copy' of your Facebook data (in Blue). The below screen will appear:





5. **SELECT** 'Start my archive'. Your archive will include: Posts, Photos and videos you've shared, your messages and Chat conversations, Information from the about section of your profile. To find out what else could be included, please visit; the Facebook HELP CENTRE under subject 'Accessing your Facebook Data'.
6. A notification box will appear informing you that the archive may take a while to prepare. **SELECT** 'Start my archive'.
7. The page will be redirected and the following page will display



8. **SELECT** 'Download Archive' and the file will begin to download. Please note that the file downloads as a ZIP FILE which contains a HTML, Photo and Index file.
9. The download dialog box will show the ZIP FILE, with your Facebook Account number in the FILENAME. Save the ZIP FILE to your storage location on your device.
10. This ZIP FILE is now accessible and can be viewed, saved and recorded for your records.
